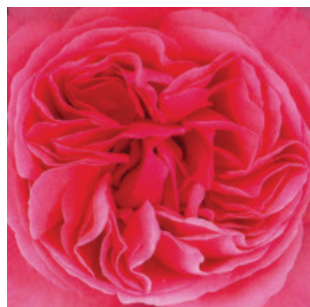

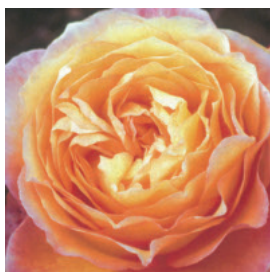

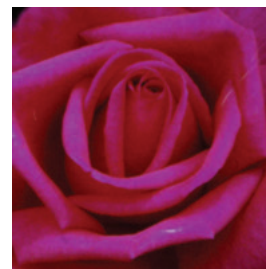

A Floribunda with deep yellow rounded HT-type blooms. The plant has healthy foliage with good disease resistance.

HAPPY RETIREMENT (Tantoras)



A useful addition to our 'special occasion' roses. Light pink double blooms borne in large clusters with good repeat flowering. The foliage is mid-green and glossy.

HOT CHOCOLATE (Wekpaltiez)



The Rose has been given the title Novelty Rose of the Year 2006, striking rusty velvets, smokey brown double blooms, with orange coloured buds. Good fragrance.

ICEBERG



This tall plant produces large sprays of snowy-white flowers, which are continuous and sweetly scented.

KORRESIA (Fresia, Sunsprite)



Golden-yellow HT-shaped blooms on growth of branching habit, dark green glossy foliage. Strong scent.

LUCKY (Rose of the Year 2009)



A cracking new floribunda quite different from anything previously seen. Pretty lilac-pink blooms are highly scented.

MANY HAPPY RETURNS (Harwanted)



A mass of blush pink blooms more or less constantly flowering till Autumn, followed by decorative orange hips. A well rounded bush with graceful, slightly pendant stems.

ORANGES & LEMONS (Macoranlem)



This eye-catching rose has clusters of flowers, striped and blotched with bright orange and lemon. New growth clothed in glossy red leaves turning to dark green with age.

REMEMBRANCE (Harxampton)



A compact scarlet with continuous blooms in great clusters on firm branches. Perfect for medium sized beds and low growing hedges.

A unique colour in roses, the nearest yet to a blue rose. The blooms are large semi-double and open fully, arrayed in large clusters on a tall plant. Sweet fragrance.

Hedging/Shrub ROSES

Give more colour to your garden by planting a rose bed. Shrub roses have a great advantage over ornamental shrubs as they are recurrent flowering and can be grown as large specimen bushes.

THE ALNWICK ROSE (Ausgrab)



Pretty rich pink deeply cupped flowers on a rounded bushy plant with a good old rose fragrance.

A SHROPSHIRE LAD (Ausled)



A strong-growing shrub with large glossy foliage and flowers of soft peachy pink with a slightly cupped formation and a deliciously fruity fragrance.

BALLERINA (Hybrid Musk)



Apple blossom-pink blooms with white eye, single, small in large clusters, recurrent flowering, vigorous growth, foliage glossy and abundant.

BLANC DOUBLE DE COUBERT



Pure white very fragrant.

BONICA (Meidomonac)



Unique pale pink blooms with an old fashioned shape; very good resistance to disease.

CHARLOTTE (Auspoly)



Cup shaped flowers of soft yellow. The growth is compact bushy and upright with a tea rose fragrance.

DARCY BUSSELL



Deep rich pink/red blooms. Perpetual flowering with strong perfume.

EGLANTYNE (Ausmak)



Pure pink flowers which are large and of exquisite rosette formation with a delicious fragrance. The bush is of medium height, broad and bushy with nice foliage.

BROTHER CADFFEL



Cupped blooms with strong old rose fragrance.

H **4x5**

Shapely flowers of rich yellow, strong tea-rose fragrance, growth vigorous and branching.

HAPPY CHILD (Auscamp)

3½x3½

Large, exceptionally rich deep yellow flowers, complemented by highly-polished medium-green leaves. Strong, bushy growth and excellent scent. Good repeat flowering.

ISABELLA (Poulisab)

6x3

An upright plant carrying deep red old fashioned scented blooms. The young foliage is bronze-red deepening to glossy dark green.

JAMES GALWAY (Auscrysal)

4.5x3.5

Large full flowers of a lovely warm pink in the centre, shading to pale pink at the edges. Strong growth and almost thornless stems make it ideal as a climber but it is also very effective as a large, rounded shrub.

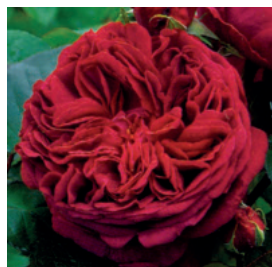

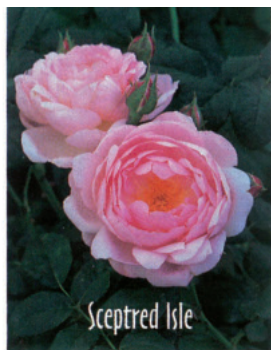

A pretty rose bearing numerous cupped flowers of soft pink, shading to a paler pink on the outer petals. An upright plant which flowers freely and continuously with a powerful fragrance.

SUSAN (Poulsue)



The many-petalled white blooms of this attractive plant open flat and quartered and are fragrant.

SWEET JULIET (Ausleap)



Shallow-cupped flowers of apricot, the petals paling to the outside. The growth is vigorous and repeat blooms particularly well, quickly producing a new crop of flowers.

THE PILGRIM (Auswalker)



Quite large yellow blooms with many small petals open to form a flat flower.

WILLIAM SHAKESPEARE 2000 (Ausroman)



Exquisite blooms of rich velvety crimson gradually changing to rich purple. Deeply cut flowers, soon opening to a shallow quartered cup. The growth is neat and upright and the roses have a strong, warm old-rose fragrance. Good disease resistance.

WINCHESTER CATHEDRAL (Auscat)



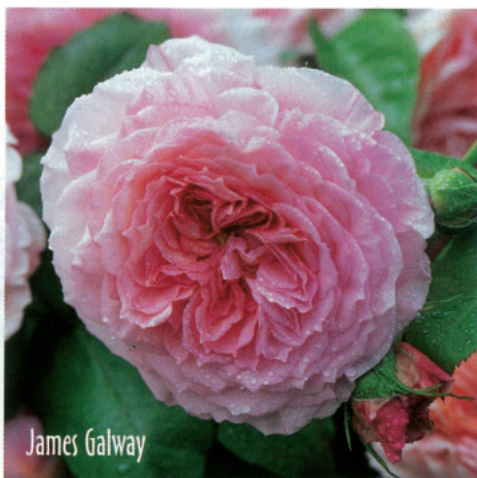

ARTHUR BELL

Golden-yellow, full blooms, strong growth with medium green leathery foliage.

BALLERINA (Reaclibal)

Bred from the famous shrub of the same name this climber gives a wonderful display of pink/white clusters on a vigorous plant.

CECILE BRUNNER (China)

 **12x12**

Light pink blooms in clusters, popular for cutting.

CHRIS (Kirsan)

Vigorous healthy Climber of rich yellow buds with an orange red shading on the outer petals. Lovely perfume.

CITY GIRL (Harzorba)

Massed clusters of orange salmon blooms. Excellent for walls, fences and pergolas.

Very full, velvety, bright red blooms; vigorous growth. Medium glossy foliage.

Deep red blooms on a strong healthy plant with a dark green, glossy foliage.

Climbing miniature flowers from top to bottom throughout summer.

Clusters of orange/red blooms on vigorous arching shrub; glossy disease-resistant foliage.

  **2×4**

Very free flowering spreading shrub with clusters of soft pink blooms.

 **2½×4**

Double blooms in large trusses; healthy foliage.

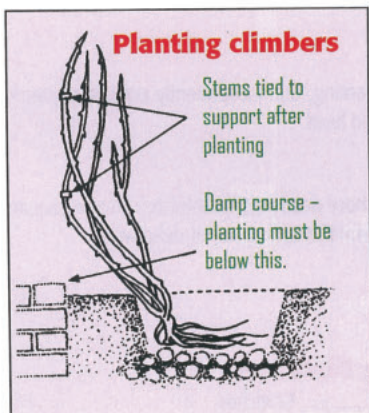

Planting Roses

Planting – all types bare root and container

Dig a hole large enough to allow the roots to spread out, without cramping their natural shape, and deep enough so that the bud union is $\frac{1}{2}$ to 1 inch below finished soil level. Cover the roots with soil a little at a time lifting the plant gently so that the soil can percolate through the roots, and 'heel in' firmly between each spade-full of soil.



If stems are shrivelled or if roots appear dry, place all of the bush in water for several hours.

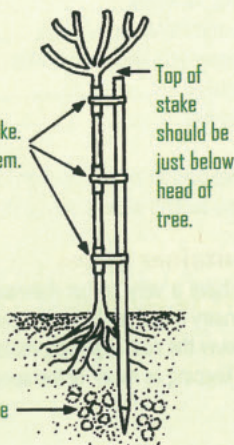


Cut back all damaged or long roots to about 12 inches.

Planting standards

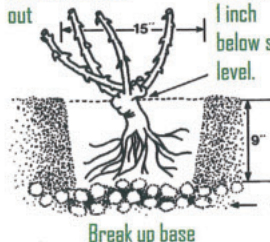
To fix, use plastic ties with stake. Plant to old soil mark on stem.

The stake should be 1 to $1\frac{1}{2}$ inches across placed on the side from which the prevailing wind blows and driven in firmly. The bottom half must be treated with a wood preservative.



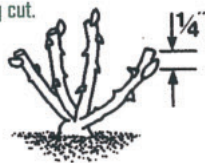
Hole should be wide enough for roots to spread out

Budding union to be 1 inch below soil level.

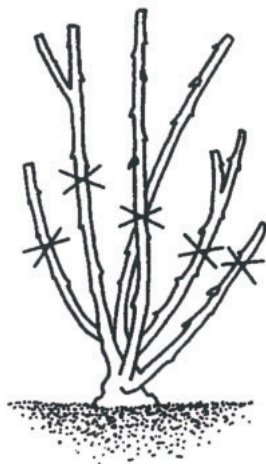


Pruning Roses

Slaping cut.



Cut back to an outward-pointing dormant bud.



In pruning established roses, remove all dead and diseased wood and all weak shoots, then prune to about half of the previous year's growth.

New Roses

Hybrid Teas or Floribundas require hard pruning during March to April depending on locality. Cut back all thin, weak and soft growth and prune back the main shoots to an outward facing eye approximately 4 to 5 inches from the union.

Established Roses

1. Cut out all dead wood and all parts of stems which are obviously diseased or damaged.
2. Cut out all thin, weak and soft shoots, aim to produce an open centred bush.
3. Only healthy and ripe stems now remain. Prune these back to 4 to 8 inches according to the thickness of the stem - the stronger the shoot the longer you leave it.

Ramblers

Do not prune the first year after planting, but subsequently cut out all stems which have flowered down to ground level.

Climbers

Do not prune the first year, merely remove dead tops. Established climbers require little pruning other than directional and the cutting out of dead wood.

Standards

Prune as bush.

Recommended Planting Distances

Patio Roses	12 inches
HTs and Floribundas	18 inches
Vigorous HTs and Floribundas	24 inches
Climbers	6 to 8 feet
Ramblers	8 to 10 feet

A rose bed 3ft wide is enough for 2 rows of Hybrid Tea or Floribunda roses and a rose bed 5ft wide is enough for 3 rows.

Container Roses

We have a very comprehensive range of roses available in containers all year round. When planting ease carefully out of the pot keeping as much of the special mixture around the roots as possible.

IMPORTANT

New roses should never be planted in old rose soil. Fresh soil is always required.

Please plant firmly.

CARE OF ROSES

It is advisable to commence spraying roses from mid April onwards, with Roseclear, to combat aphids, and to prevent Mildew and Blackspot – this should be carried out twice monthly until the end of September.

We recommend a Spring feed with a well balanced fertilizer such as RosePlus after pruning has been completed. To encourage a continuity of bloom during the Summer, dead flowers should be removed before seed pods form and a fortnightly feed of Tomorite.

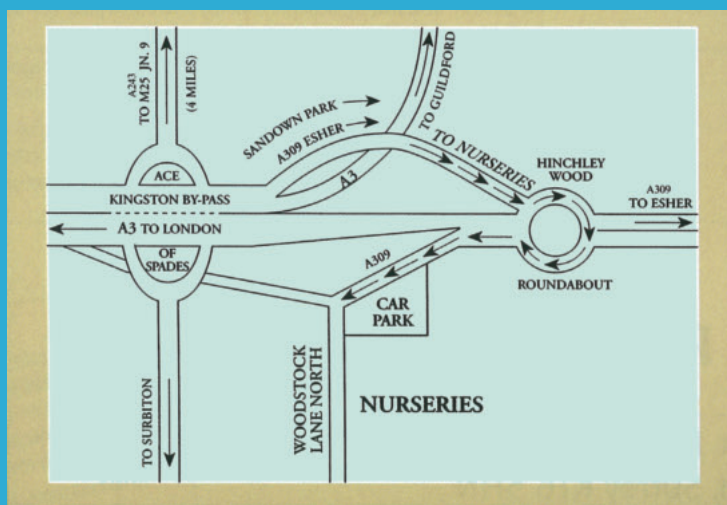
